**MIDDLE ATLANTIC PRODUCTS AXS CUSTOM MILLWORK ENCLOSURE
SYSTEM SOLVES SPACE CHALLENGE IN NEW JERSEY SUPER-HOME**

INDIANAPOLIS, INDIANA, September 9, 2004 — In an application that demonstrates its commitment to space, thermal and cable management, Middle Atlantic Products announced the successful installation of four AXS enclosure systems at a luxurious Saddle River, New Jersey home. Designed by the Electronics Design Group (EDG) of Piscataway, New Jersey, the Middle Atlantic Products AXS enclosure systems house all equipment for a whole house audio system, a media and home theater system, and all local electronics for the basement and family room.

“Due to the lack of space we had to work with and the amount of equipment occupying that space, we needed to provide our customer with an enclosure system that fit into the space of the custom millwork that was easily accessible, for service and upgrades,” said Robert Modica, Systems Sales and Design Manager at EDG. “The AXS enclosure system from Middle Atlantic Products was a perfect fit because it allows us to easily access the rear of the installed equipment without causing any harm to the custom millwork and cabinetry.”

The main media/home theater room includes a state of the art AMX Control System as well as a central audio system comprised of a 400-disc Sony CD-Changer and DSS receiver along with Sonance amplifiers and a Rotel AM/FM stereo tuner and a 7.1 Dolby Digital Surround System. Video equipment includes a 60” Sony Rear-Projector, DVD players, S-VHS video recorder, digital network recorders and HDTV Satellite receiver. All media forms are controlled via an AMX Wireless Color Touchpanel.

According to Modica, Middle Atlantic Products cable and thermal management products were a significant factor in the installation process. “In a sealed cabinet

and enclosure system where the entertainment system can be running up to 16 hours a day for specific zones throughout the house, keeping the equipment at a safe operating temperature is paramount. What's more, since the enclosure systems house the whole-home audio system and home theater system, there are vast amounts of cable going through the enclosure system," Modica said. "Middle Atlantic Products line of thermal and cable management accessories allowed us to effectively manage all cable and heated air within the custom cabinetry and enclosure system, helping prevent system failure and allowing for easy access to connected equipment."

Middle Atlantic Products AXS racks are available in models that either install in walls and millwork or come factory assembled within the company's MRK, WRK-SA or ERK enclosures, allowing systems to be placed against walls or back-to-back. The systems offer rack frame heights from 10 to 43 spaces and can accommodate up to 650 pounds of equipment with proper weight distribution. Installation is simplified through the use of a mechanically interlocking corner joint, which also contributes to the strength and rigidity of the AXS system. Articulating carriers attach to the rack frame for effective cable management and each service track includes a built-in level.

Both the AXS models for millwork and in-wall as well as those for steel racks are EIA compliant. The AXS system installed in the Middle Atlantic Products MRK Series racks offers the added security of satisfying the Uniform Building Code seismic zone 4 upper floor requirements for protecting 500 pounds of essential equipment.
